Analysis - Feedback was collected from 438 Students from 13 departments. The feedback contains questionnaire on teaching Learning process having 12 points and on college Infrastructure having 17 points. The response on this feedback form consists of 5 points as (1) Strongly Disagree, (2) Disagree, (3) Satisfactory, (4) Agree, (5) Strongly Agree. The overall institutional performance is measured by the students' response as 95% students agree with performance of the institute where 2% remains undecided on this topic. The issues behind their satisfaction are mainly guidance of teachers, participation and discussion in class, encouragement for ethical values, linkage of subject to the real life, and cover of syllabus in time and periodical assessment. However, a demand has come from science based students to implement based learning. Student's response on the infrastructure lacks some areas such as internet facility, medical facility and sports facility.

Action Taken - Feedback committee has conveyed the analysis of the feedback to the principal through IQAC. Meeting with the principal takes up the following steps.

- 1- To purchase more books in Science Departments
- 2- Focus on activity based learning.
- 3- The college will take step with the approval of Governing Body for providing internal facility and sports facility.
- 4- Grievances/ problems are to be redressed well in time.






Periodical Assessments



Traditional method of evaluation










Analysis - Feedback was collected from parents on four points as to the progress of their ward and it was placed before the principal for analysis. On examination of the feedback it is found that 80% parents are satisfied with the progress of their ward.
